Following are items they are accepting donations for to take with them to Uganda: Multivitamins for Children and Adults, Prenatal vitamins, Acetaminophen, Ibuprofen, Antibiotic Cream or Ointment, Alergy medicine , such as Benedryl or Zyrtec, Antioxizillian for children or adults, Robitussin, Zicam- cough medicine,Zantac, Previcid, Prilosec (heartburn), Lisinopril, Imodium, Metform, Oral Rehydration Salts, Antifungal creams, Lotrim.
