The Church at Thessalonica started on Paul's second Missionary journey. He was beaten and imprisoned in Phillippi until an earthquake freed him. He leaves there and heads to this city of 200,000 people. It was located on the on the sea coast and was an important city for trade. What better place to plant a church that would interact with people from all over the world and aid in the spread of the Gospel. There was a large Jewish synagogue in Thessolinica as well as a strong pagan following. The population of the city was a majority of Greeks, the city was named after Alexander the Great's sister. Romans were the second most populous group. Jews were a minority but there was a large number of them. Paul was forced out of Thessalonica when his host Jason's home was invaded by pagans and Jews looking to end his Gospel work.
